INSPECTION TIPS FOR HOUSING CHOICE VOUCHER HOUSING

Below is a list of the most common discrepancies found during Housing Choice Voucher housing quality standards (HQS) inspections:

- 1. Smoke detector(s) not working.
- 2. Peeling, cracking or flaking interior or exterior paint.
- 3. Leaking plumbing, such as faucets, pipe joints and toilets.
- 4. Tripping hazards from permanently installed floor coverings.
- 5. Electrical outlet plates missing, cracked, or missing screws.
- 6. Inoperable burners or missing control knobs on stoves.
- 7. Windows which require a prop to keep them open.
- 8. Windows with missing or broken locks.
- 9. Cracked or broken window panes.
- 10. Missing or inoperable window cranking mechanisms in mobile homes.
- 11. Rotten wood in soffits and fascia.
- 12. Lack of tenant-supplied utilities (usually caused by failure of tenant to pay utility bill).
- 13. Soft spots in bathroom floor around tub or toilet.
