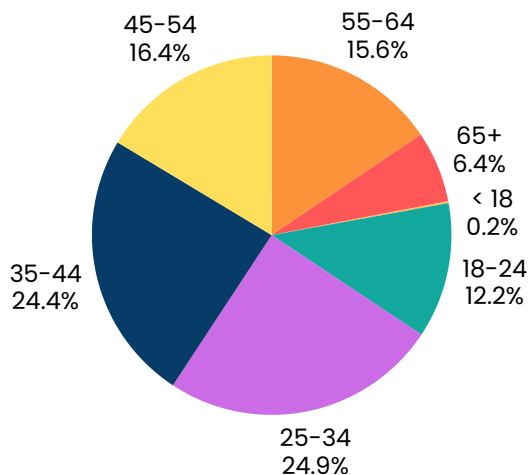

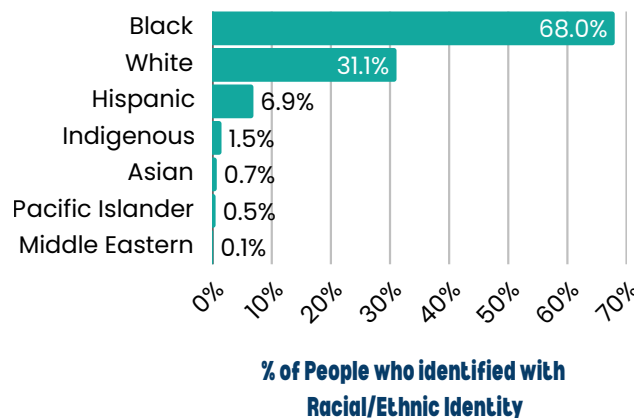

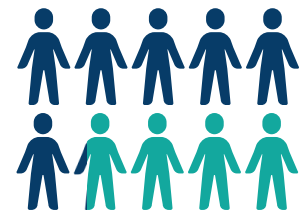

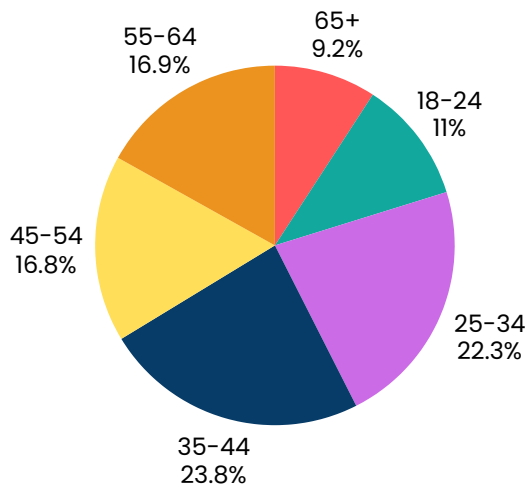

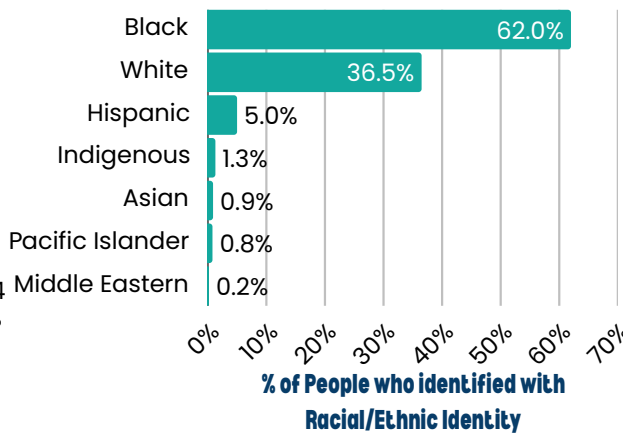

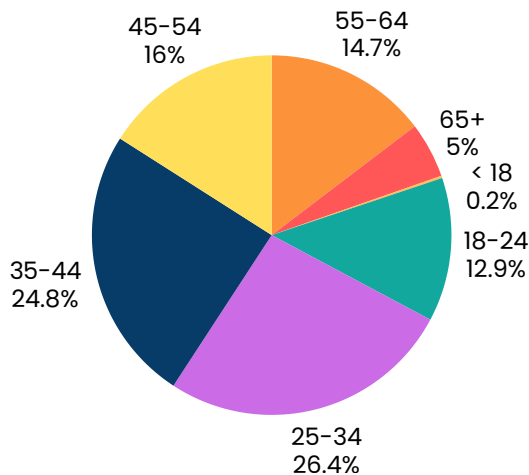

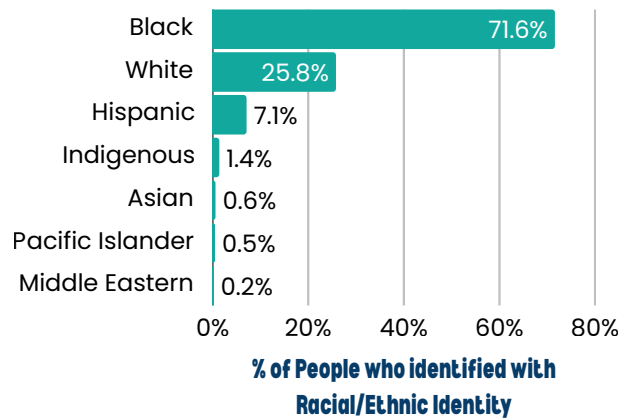

Contacts By Race/Ethnicity

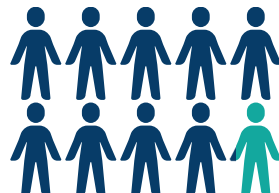
